1 Day Tour

Sit back and relax⁴ on this day tour of San Francisco. You can hop on and off the bus at 26 different sights. We will take you to the **Golden Gate Bridge**, **Chinatown** and **Pier 39**.

2 Night Tour

This tour will show you San Francisco at night. Starting at **Fisherman's Wharf**, you'll make your way through the city to the **Bay Bridge** where you can look at the beautiful skyline.

3 Alcatraz Tour

This tour gives you all the benefits⁵ of the day tour. On top of that you can take the ferry⁶ to one of the most famous prisons in the world, **Alcatraz**, and visit the museum there.
